
The attached correspondence is forwarded for presentation to the Albany County Legislature.

I am pleased to announce that Albany County has been awarded \$1,200,054 under the New York State 2020 Statewide Interoperable Communications Grant Program (2020 SICG-Formula). This program, administered by my agency, allows for the State support to aid county, local and municipal public safety organizations in enhancing emergency response, improving capability, improvements in governance structures, operating procedures, infrastructure development, and addressing SAFECOM guidance from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security Office of Emergency Communications (OEC). The 2020 SICG-Formula Program will concentrate on improving interoperability and operability of communications systems in New York State. Your participation in this program is another example of the successful partnerships we have been developing for public safety and emergency preparedness across the State.

The performance period for the 2020-SICG-Formula grant will be 24 months, beginning January 1, 2021 – December 31, 2022, with the possibility of an extension based upon a good cause shown and ample justification for needing additional time. In order to provide these funds to you as quickly as possible, we will need to gather budget information within 45 calendar days from the date of this letter that reflects the award amount. The Albany County Executive's Office, on behalf of the Department of Health (DOH) and the Division of Information Services (DIS), and the Albany County Sheriff's Office respectfully request legislative authorization to accept the Fiscal Year 2021 State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) and State Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Program (SLETPP) grants from the NYS Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services (DHSES).


The County was awarded a total of \$635,474 in funding: 1) \$565,212 under FY2021 SHSP for the Department of Health and the Division of Information Services, and 2) \$70,262 under FY2021 SLETPP for the Sheriff's Office. The County Executive and Sheriff require separate contracts with NYS DHSES.

The SHSP and SLETPP annual funding opportunities support sustainment of existing capabilities and development of new ones. The DOH intends to use \$381,212 for the continued coordination of emergency preparedness programs, trainings, equipment and exercises (including the sustainment of the Albany County Citizen Corps and health preparedness planning). The DIS anticipates using \$184,000 for cyber security (including data storage, threat detection equipment, and multi-factor authentication). The Sheriff's Office anticipates using \$70,262 awarded under FY2021 SLETPP grant for security enhancements to critical infrastructure.

The DOH and DIS will budget their grant money into subsequent annual County budgets. The Sheriff's Office requests a budget amendment to include their award amount in the current 2021 Budget. State Homeland Security Program and State Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Program grants are both 100% state funded with no County match requirement.

The County Executive’s Office, on behalf of the Department of Health and the Division of Information Services, and the Sheriff’s Office are requesting authorization to accept the NYS Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services (DHSES) FY2021 State Homeland Security Program/State Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Program (SHSP/SLETPP) grants in the amount of \$635,474. Separate contracts are needed for DOH/DIS (\$565,212) and the Sheriff’s Office (\$70,262). DIS will receive \$184,000.00 of the total, utilized for the enhancement of the County’s cyber security. DOH will receive \$381,212.00 of the total, utilized to coordinate and sustain citizen preparedness, public health planning, replenishing PPE stockpile, and training/exercise programs. Both DIS and DOH will budget their awards into subsequent annual County budgets. The Albany County Sheriff’s Office will use \$70,262.00 awarded under SLETPP for security enhancements to critical infrastructure. The Sheriff’s Office is requesting a budget amendment to include the funds in their 2021 Budget. There is no County match for these grants.
