Dear Chairman Joyce,

The Department of Social Services respectfully requests legislative approval for the following:

The Albany County Department of Social Services has found the current policy of requiring applicants to reside within the County to be severely limiting in our recruitment efforts and has restricted our ability to hire qualified candidates for Eligibility Examiner I and Caseworker positions. Since the pandemic, the Department has had ongoing difficulty in recruiting, hiring and training for our entry-level Caseworker, and Eligibility Examiner I positions because of a significant decline in non-remote work labor force participation and competition from adjacent municipal and state agencies.

Adjacent municipalities, including Rensselaer and Schenectady Counties, both waive a residency requirement. Non-local applicants can apply to these municipalities to seek employment. Albany County is also at a disadvantage because positions at NYS as well as some of our contiguous counties often offer higher rates of pay and applicants have a choice of residency.

Albany County DSS has diligently sought out qualified applicants by posting these position openings both internally and externally through Indeed and the Albany County Civil Service Employment web page to encourage applicants for these positions. Of the 1,405 that viewed our post for Eligibility Examiners on Indeed, 148 persons submitted resumes. After providing notice of the minimum qualifications and residency requirements, 19 completed the required County application. Of those 19, seven did not meet minimum qualifications and 3 withdrew. Of the 1,236 views of the Caseworker post, 109 candidates submitted resumes and we received a total of 5 applications.

Due to our unsuccessful attempts to secure enough qualified applicants for our multiple vacant entry level positions we are requesting a waiver to seek potential applicants residing outside of Albany County so we can immediately perform our vital functions and services to meet the needs of our most vulnerable populations and get into compliance with our regulatory requirements.
