Chairman Volk convened the meeting at 7:04 PM and called the roll (see above). The minutes from July 11<sup>th</sup> were approved (1 Abstention).

The commission began by discussing the 7 MMD district map formally transmitted to the Commission by the MMD redistricting subcommittee. The subcommittee chair presented the map to the commission. She explained why the MMD chose this map over the other options, and provided the subcommittee's rationale for doing so. She briefly detailed the minor changes that were made to the original Plan C map. Chairman Volk invited the other subcommittee members to add their views. After this there was discussion between ACRC and MMD members about the map. The commission then voted and approved the MMD's new map unanimously.

The commission then discussed at length the possibility of holding another public hearing. Legal counsel had not yet spoken with the County Attorney on the precise interpretation of Local Law 8's section K.2., but he stated that he believed a public hearing would be a good idea even if not legally required. Several members spoke of the large number of changes that would have to be made to accommodate the subcommittee's 7-MMD map. Other commission members were concerned that extending the hearing process into August will give the County Legislature less time to consider the Local Law, and questioned whether public comments from the hearing would lead to yet another round of changes to the map. After all members were given the opportunity to express their views, it was moved and seconded to hold an additional public hearing on Thursday August 4 beginning at 5 pm. The motion was unanimously approved. Plans were made to hold a mapping workshop on July 17<sup>th</sup> at 7 pm, with a second mapping workshop

on July 18<sup>th</sup> at 4 pm in place of the regular Monday meeting, and with the whole commission reviewing the finished map on July 21<sup>st</sup> at 7 pm. The potential for a press conference sometime around July 26<sup>th</sup> was also discussed.

## The next ACRC meeting will be on Thursday July 21<sup>st</sup> at 7pm.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:12 pm.
