- 1. Reviewed the meeting minutes from the September 21, 2022 meeting, a motion from Mr. Melita to adopt the minutes without modification was seconded by Mr. Malone, and the meeting minutes were adopted unanimously.
- 2. An update on the return of the Financial Disclosure Forms was provided by Mr. Collins
 - a. A review to find any pattern in the delinquent filers found the Sheriff's Department struggled in compliance.
 - b. The Ethics Commission directed the Clerk of Legislature to send a hard copy of a delinquent filers list directly to the Sheriff's Department and provide 30 days for employees to return their forms.
 - c. The Ethics Commission will review any newly provided Financial Disclosures Forms at its next meeting.
- 3. Motion to move into Executive Session to discuss the Ethics Complaint submitted on October 19, 2022 ("Ethics Complaint") and to discuss the employment history of a particular person (OML §105(1)(f)) was made by Mr. Malone, Mr. Melita seconded. The motion was unanimous.
- 4. Motion to move out of Executive Session was made by Mr. Melita, Mr. Malone seconded. The motion was unanimous.
- 5. Motion made pursuant to the Ethics Law, Local Law 8 for 2011, Section (5)(1)(c) and pursuant to Albany County Ethics Commission Regulations Governing Complaints and Investigations Paragraph (3) to undertake a preliminary review phase of the Ethics Complaint was made by Mr. Malone, seconded by Mr. Melita. The motion was unanimous.
 - a. The Clerk of the Legislature is to request that Complainant sign and swear to any amendments previously submitted before they are considered part of the record
 - b. A formal notice will be drafted by Ethics Counsel and reviewed by the Ethics Commission before it is provided to the Respondent
- 6. The Commission discussed its next meeting and a tentative date was set for January 25, 2023 at 3 pm.

7. Motion to adjourn – Mr. Melita moved to adjourn, Mr. Malone seconded. The motion was unanimous.
