AUTHORIZING AGREEMENTS REGARDING LONG TERM CARE POINT OF ENTRY SERVICES

WHEREAS, The Albany County Department for Aging has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the New York State Office for the Aging regarding grant funding for the operation of Albany County - NY Connects, Long Term Care Point of Entry Services in an amount not to exceed of \$31,071 for the term commencing October 1, 2017 and ending March 31, 2018, and

WHEREAS, Albany County - NY Connects, Long Term Care Point of Entry Services provides information, screening, referral/linkage assistance and public education to all persons in need of long term care services, regardless of age or income, and

WHEREAS, The Department has also requested authorization to enter into an interdepartmental agreement with the Albany County Department of Social Services regarding the provision of Long Term Care Point of Entry Services for the term commencing October 1, 2017 and ending March 31, 2018, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the New York State Office for the Aging regarding the provision of Albany County - NY Connects, Long Term Care Point of Entry Services in an amount not to exceed \$31,071 for the term commencing October 1, 2017 and ending March 31, 2018, and, be it further

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that an interdepartmental agreement is authorized between the Albany County Departments of Aging and Social Services in an amount not to exceed \$31,071 regarding the provision of Albany County - NY Connects, Long Term Care Point of Entry Services for the term commencing October 1, 2017 and ending March 31, 2018, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreements as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate and County Officials.
