AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CAPITAL DISTRICT TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY REGARDING THE EXPANSION OF THE BIKE SHARE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Albany County Executive requested authorization to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Capital District Transportation Authority (CDTA) for the purpose of allowing the expansion of the bike share program on county property, and

WHEREAS, The County Executive indicated that expansion of the current program would provide the public with an alternative means of transportation and recreation in the county, including along the Albany County Rail Trail, and

WHEREAS, It was indicated that there will be no expense to the county and the bike share sites will be owned, operated and maintained by CDTA; the racks are currently operated in various locations across the Capital District and would allow for an extension of that system, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an MOU with CDTA for the purpose of allowing the expansion of bike share program on county property, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
