WHEREAS, The State of New York passed the Raise the Age Law which will reduce the number of minors treated as adults in the criminal justice system but increase the number of minors housed in youth facilities, and

WHEREAS, The Capital District Youth Center's capability to handle the additional population that has been removed from the adult criminal justice system needs to assessed, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Management and Budget has requested a budget amendment to accept funding from the counties utilizing the facility to pay for services to be provided under a previously approved contact with SMRT Architects to assess that capability, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the 2018 General Services Building Services Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A2770 Unclassified Revenues by \$48,000

Increase Appropriation Account A1620.4 by \$48,000 by increasing Line Item A1620 4 4406 Fees for Services by \$48,000

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
