Barnard, 21 Balsam Way, Albany, NY 12205, be appointed as the sportsperson representative on the Regional Fish and Wildlife Management Board, Kevin Busch, 14 Leonard Drive Niskayuna, NY 12309 be appointed as an alternate sportsperson representative on the Regional Fish and Wildlife Management Board and Nicholas Viscio Town of Knox, for a term ending December 31, 2018, and, be it further
