WHEREAS, Attendance is taken at such meetings and gatherings by the Clerk of the Legislature pursuant to the Legislative Rules of Order, and

WHEREAS, It is in the public interest that the attendance of legislators at such meetings, hearings and forums be provided to the public for their inspection, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature, that the Clerk of the Legislature shall take such steps necessary to post to the County website the attendance records of any such legislative meeting, public hearing, committee meeting or public forum for which the taking of attendance is required pursuant to the Legislative Rules of Order, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
