AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE FOR THE AGING REGARDING THE PROVISION OF SUPPORTIVE SERVICES FOR SENIORS IN ALBANY COUNTY

WHEREAS, The Department for Aging has been notified by the NYS Office for the Aging that Title III-B funds are available for various supportive service programs to provide transportation, adult day services, case management, preventive health services and shopping assistance for low income seniors in Albany County, and

WHEREAS, The Department has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging in an amount not to exceed \$266,972 for the term commencing January 1, 2019 and ending December 31, 2019 regarding supportive services for seniors in Albany County, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging in an amount not to exceed \$266,972 for the term commencing January 1, 2019 and ending December 31, 2019 regarding supportive services for seniors in Albany County, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
