AUTHORIZING RENEWAL OF AN AGREEMENT WITH CAYUGA CENTERS REGARDING THE PROVISION OF CLINICAL PREVENTION SERVICES WITH COMMUNITY AND RECREATIONAL SUPPORTS

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Children, Youth and Families has requested authorization to enter an agreement with Cayuga Centers for the provision of Clinical Services through its Intensive Family Support Program that targets at-risk families with children age birth to five (5) years old since the Department has identified this age group as having the highest admissions to foster care, and

WJEREAS, The proposed contract is for the term commencing January 1, 2019 and ending December 31, 2019 in the amount of \$231,724, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Cayuga Centers regarding the provision of Clinical Prevention Services with Community and Recreational Supports for the term commencing January 1, 2019 and ending December 31, 2019 in the amount of \$231,724 and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
