WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff has requested authorization to apply for \$333,449 in grant funding from the NYS Office of Homeland Security regarding the Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Program for the period September 1 2016 through August 31, 2018, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff indicated that no County share or in-kind match is required and the Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Program grant funds will be used to fund a part-time Deputy Director of Emergency Management and the 800mhz Albany County Interoperable Communications Project and purchase a generator for back-up power at the Emergency Operations Center, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a grant application to the New York State Office of Homeland Security for the Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Program in the amount of \$333,449 for the period September 1, 2016 through August 31, 2018, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said grant application as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
