

RESOLUTION NO. 534

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH HOMELESS TRAVELERS AID SOCIETY REGARDING SUPPORT SERVICES FOR MENTALLY ILL CHILDREN AND THEIR FAMILIES

WHEREAS, The Director of the Department of Mental Health has recommended the approval of an agreement with Homeless Travelers Aid Society for the provision of intensive case management services and transportation planning and accommodations for citizens of Albany County whose children are hospitalized in adolescent psychiatric units primarily located outside of Albany County, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Homeless Travelers Aid Society regarding the provision of intensive case management services and transportation planning and accommodations in an amount not to exceed \$534,661 for the period commencing January 1, 2017 and ending December 31, 2017, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
