RE-LEVY OF UNPAID TOWN SCHOOL TAXES

Introduced: 12/19/16 By Mr. Domalewicz and Audit and Finance Committee:

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature, pursuant to the Real Property Tax Law, that the report of the Tax Record Manager of the Albany County Division of Finance together with the accounts of unpaid town school taxes submitted be received and placed on file, and the amounts of such unpaid school taxes with the seven per centum (7%) addition thereto, be levied upon the lands of each person, corporation and unincorporated company, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That out of any moneys in the County Treasury raised for contingent expenses or for the purposes of paying the amount of unpaid town school taxes so returned unpaid, the Albany County Division of Finance pay to the District Treasurer, if there be such an office, otherwise to the collector of the school district, the amount thereof, hereby re-levied, in the same manner as other County charges are paid and the collector shall be charged by the trustees with the amount so relevied, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the amount of such unpaid town school taxes with the seven per centum (7%) of the amount in addition thereto, be re-levied and when collected shall be returned to the Albany County Division of Finance to reimburse the amount so advanced with the expense of collection, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
