AUTHORIZING AGREEMENTS REGARDING THE CHILDREN'S ADVOCACY CENTER AND AMENDING THE 2015 DEPARTMENT FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES BUDGET

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Children, Youth and Families has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office of Children and Family Services regarding the Children's Advocacy Center for the period commencing February 1, 2015 and ending January 31, 2016 in the amount of \$199,421, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has also requested authorization to renew an interdepartmental agreement with the Albany County Crime Victims and Violence Center for the same term indicated above in the amount of \$40,000 regarding the investigation and prosecution of child abuse cases, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has also requested authorization to renew an agreement with Forensic Nurse Practitioners of Schenectady, LLP for the same term indicated above in the amount of \$2,999 regarding the provision of nonemergency medical exams on site at the Children's Advocacy Center for children and youth who are alleged to be victims of child abuse, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner also requested a budget amendment in order to incorporate \$128,876 of the aforementioned funding into the 2015 Department for Children, Youth and Families Budget, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter an agreement with the NYS Office of Children and Family Services regarding the aforementioned grant award in the amount of \$199,421 for the period February 1, 2015 through January 31, 2016, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Executive is also authorized to execute an interdepartmental agreement between the Department for Children, Youth and Families and the Albany County Crime Victims and Violence Center in the amount of \$40,000 for the period February 1, 2015 through January 31, 2016, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Executive is also authorized to enter into an agreement with Forensic Nurse Practitioners of Schenectady, LLP in the amount of \$2,999 for the period February 1, 2015 through January 31, 2016, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2015 Department for Children, Youth and Families Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A3407 Child Advocacy Center by \$128,876

Increase Appropriation Account A6119.4 by \$128,876 by increasing the following Line Items:

A6119 4 4020 Office Supplies by \$4,500 A6119 4 4036 Telephone \$2,220 A6119 4 4040 Books/Transcripts/Subscripts \$1,000 A6119 4 4042 Printing and Advertising \$20,710 A6119 4 4046 Fees For Services by \$100,446

RESOLVED, That the Albany County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreements as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
