AUTHORIZING AGREEMENTS REGARDING A JUVENILE RE-ENTRY CONSORTIUM INITIATIVE AND AMENDING THE 2015 DEPARTMENT FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES BUDGET

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Children, Youth and Families has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with Rensselaer County as the lead agency of a four-county collaborative Juvenile Re-entry Consortium Initiative which will include Albany, Columbia and Schenectady Counties and an agreement with the Research Foundation for the State University of New York regarding the research for the initiative, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has also requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the Vera Institute of Justice in order to accept funding in the amount of \$5,000 regarding the Consortium Initiative for the period October 1, 2014 to December 31, 2016, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into agreements with the Vera Institute of Justice in order to accept funding in the amount of \$5,000; the State University of New York regarding the research for the initiative and an agreement with Rensselaer County as the lead agency of the Consortium Initiative for the period October 1, 2014 to December 31, 2016, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2015 Department for Children, Youth and Families Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Appropriation Account A6119.4 by \$2,500 by increasing Line Item A6119 4 4038 Travel/Mileage/Freight by \$2,500

Increase Appropriation Account A6119.4 by \$2,500 by increasing Line Item A6119 4 4039 Conferences/Training/Tuition by \$2,500

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreements as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of the resolution the appropriate County Officials.
