WHEREAS, The Director of the Crime Victim and Sexual Violence Center has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the City of Albany regarding traffic and crowd control provided by the Police Department and emergency medical services provided by the Fire Department on Tuesday, April 21, 2015 from 4:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., and

WHEREAS, This is the 34th Annual Take Back the Night March for the Crime Victim and Sexual Violence Center, the purpose of this event is to raise awareness around the issues of violence against women and to encourage community mobilization, and

WHEREAS, The rally will begin at The College of Saint Rose, proceed to march from Madison Avenue and continue to Western Avenue where a vigil will then take place, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the City of Albany regarding police attendance and emergency medical services at the 34th Annual Take Back the Night Rally and March Against Sexual Violence on Tuesday, April 21, 2015, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
