WHEREAS, The County Executive has requested authorization to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with AJW Incorporated, the Albany City School District and the Albany Police Department to work in collaboration with the Department of Mental Health, Department for Children, Youth and Families, and the Probation Department within Albany County regarding the Community, Opportunity, Reinvestment (CORe) Initiative, and

WHEREAS, The CORe initiative will allow for the transmission of data from each involved party to AJW Incorporated for analysis, which will identify significantly at risk individuals in need of intense services to break the cycle of poverty and recidivism and also address disparities in employment, public safety, education, health and housing, and

WHEREAS, The County Executive indicated that all expenses for the CORe initiative will be funded by the State of New York and will coordinate State support with local needs to better allocate resources and make measurable progress, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into all necessary agreements regarding the Community, Opportunity, Reinvestment (CORe) Initiative, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreements as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
