WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Children, Youth and Families has requested authorization to submit a grant application for up to \$10,000 to the Hudson River Valley Greenway Grant Program regarding repairs to the barn at Lawson Lake, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner indicated that the funding would be used for the purposes of evaluating the structural integrity of the barn at Lawson Lake and to commence the necessary repairs in order to accommodate community organizations and the general public who may utilize the barn for various programs, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner further indicated that, if successful, the grant requires that Albany County provide a 50% match of the amount awarded which may be met utilizing in-kind services, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a grant application for funding up to \$10,000 to the Hudson River Valley Greenway Grant Program regarding evaluating the structural integrity of the barn at Lawson Lake, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said grant application as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
