## **RESOLUTION NO. 209**

REQUESTING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO PROVIDE ALL DOCUMENTATION REGARDING EMPLOYEES WHO PRESUMABLY FALL UNDER THE EXACT CIRCUMSTANCES OUTLINED IN RESOLUTION NO. 128 FOR 2015

By Messrs. Commisso, Morse and Nichols:

WHEREAS, By Resolution 128 for 2015, this Honorable Body authorized a limited exception to the employment rules and regulations resulting from an administrative delay that was beyond an employee's control, if unchanged would have denied said employee the full scope of health insurance coverage for which he was entitled, and

WHEREAS, Despite the fact that documentation indicated that said employee was offered the position prior to the 1999 rules change, the County Executive still vetoed Resolution No. 128 for 2015, and

WHEREAS, In opposition to Resolution No. 128 for 2015, it was asserted by the County Executive as part of his reasoning to vetoing the Resolution, and echoed by his supporters, that as many as 50 other employees would also be entitled to such an exception, and

WHEREAS, This Honorable Body has a long and rich history of protecting its employees and correcting administrative oversights, and will continue to rectify the situations of those employees who are in the same exact circumstances as the aforementioned employee, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is requested to provide within 30 days of the passage of this resolution any and all information and documentation concerning those aforementioned employees who were offered and accepted employment prior to the September 1999 rules change, and presumably are entitled to relief under the same circumstances as those stated in Resolution No. 128 for 2015, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
