

RESOLUTION NO. 278

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY REGARDING AN EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERFORMANCE GRANT

By Public Safety Committee and Mr. Clenahan:

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff requested authorization to submit a grant application and enter into a two-year agreement with the NYS Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services in the amount of \$119,461 regarding an Emergency Management Performance Grant for the period October 1, 2014 to September 30, 2016, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff indicated that funding would be used to support personnel and fringe benefit costs in the amount of \$115,000, travel expense for planning, training and exercises in the amount of \$1,921 and miscellaneous expenses in the amount of \$2,540, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff indicated that a County match in the amount of \$119,461 is required, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a grant application and enter into a two-year agreement with the NYS Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services in an amount not to exceed \$119,461 regarding an Emergency Management Performance Grant for the period October 1, 2014 to September 30, 2016, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said application and agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
