WHEREAS, The Sewer District has requested authorization to submit a grant application regarding the replacement of three Return Sludge pumps and three Waste Activated sludge pumps at the North and South Plants for a total of twelve new pumps, and

WHEREAS, It is in the best interest of the County to submit said application for financial assistance, now, therefore be it,
