

RESOLUTION NO. 327

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES REGARDING RAPE CRISIS SERVICES AND AMENDING THE 2015 CRIME VICTIM AND SEXUAL VIOLENCE CENTER BUDGET

By Law Committee, Ms. McKnight and Mr. Clenahan:

WHEREAS, The Director of the Crime Victim Sexual Violence Center has requested authorization to submit a grant application and enter into an agreement with the Division of Criminal Justice Services regarding Rape Crisis Services in the amount of \$56,000 for the period beginning September 1, 2015 and ending March 31, 2016, and

WHEREAS, The Director indicated that funding will be used to support primary prevention education, rape crisis services, assorted training and operational cost, and

WHEREAS, The Director has also requested a budget amendment in order to incorporate the aforementioned funding, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a grant application and enter into an agreement to the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services regarding Rape Crisis Services for the period beginning September 1, 2015 through March 31, 2016 in an amount not to exceed \$56,000, and, be it further

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the 2015 Crime Victim Sexual Violence Center is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account 3497 Violence Against Woman Action by \$56,000

Increase Appropriation Account A4610.1 by \$2,330 by increasing Line Item A4610 1 9982 On Call Pay by \$2,330

Increase Appropriation Account A4610.4 by \$53,670 by increasing the following Line Items:

Increase A4610 4 4039 Conferences by \$2,000

Increase A4610 4 4046 Fees for Services by \$51,670

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said grant application and agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
