WHEREAS, The Department for Children, Youth and Families, after an RFP process, has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with Cayuga Centers regarding the provision of clinical prevention services for the period commencing January 1, 2016 and ending December 31, 2016 in the amount of \$222,205, and

WHEREAS, Cayuga Centers will provide clinical services through its Intensive Family Support Program that targets at-risk families with children age birth to five years old since the Department has identified this age group as having the highest admissions to foster care, and

WHEREAS, The agreement provides comprehensive assessment, diagnostic testing, case and specialized therapies provided by a person who has received a Master of Social Work degree, Master of Mental Health Counseling degree or is a licensed Psychologist, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Cayuga Centers regarding the provision of clinical prevention services for the period commencing January 1, 2016 and ending December 31, 2016 in the amount of \$222,205, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
