WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff requested authorization to enter into an agreement with Tetra Tech, Inc. in the amount of \$300,000 for training and governance services regarding the Interoperable Public Safety Communications System for the period October 1, 2015 to September 30, 2016, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff indicated that the agreement with Tetra Tech, Inc. would be funded through a \$6,000,000 grant from the NYS Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services, Office of Interoperable and Emergency Communications, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff indicated that training and governance services are requirements of an Interoperable Communications Grant, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Tetra Tech, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$300,000 for training and governance services regarding the Interoperable Public Safety Communications System for the period October 1, 2015 to September 30, 2016, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
