WHEREAS, The Sheriff has requested authorization to submit a grant application and enter into a multi-year agreement with the NYS Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services regarding a Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness Grant in the amount of \$17,147 for the period September 1, 2014 to January 31, 2016, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has indicated that the funding will be used to hire a consultant to prepare and evaluate an exercise related to Hazmat response to a crude oil incident, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has also requested a budget amendment to accept the aforementioned funding, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a grant application and enter into a two-year agreement with the NYS Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services regarding a Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness Grant in an amount not to exceed \$17,147 for the period September 1, 2014 to January 31, 2016, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2015 Sheriff's Department Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A3306 Homeland Security by \$17,147

Increase Appropriation Account A3110.4 by \$17,147 by increasing Line Item A3110 4 4046 Fees for Services by \$17,147

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said grant application and agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
