AUTHORIZING AGREEMENTS REGARDING THE CRIME VICTIM AND SEXUAL VIOLENCE CENTER'S PROVISION OF SERVICES FOR THE GOVERNOR'S ENOUGH IS ENOUGH CAMPAIGN

By Law Committee and Mr. Clenahan:

WHEREAS, The Director of the Albany County Crime Victim and Sexual Violence Center has indicated that the Governor's Enough is Enough Campaign requires institutions of higher learning to work closely with local sexual assault programs and it recommends having agreements with the local rape crisis counseling center, and

WHEREAS, The Director has requested authorization to enter into agreements with The Sage Colleges, The Albany College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences, Siena College, the College of Saint Rose, Albany Law School, and the University at Albany pursuant the Governor's Enough is Enough Campaign which requires all colleges to adopt a set of comprehensive procedures and guidelines, including a uniform definition of affirmative consent, and expanded access to law enforcement to help prevent rape on college campuses in New York State, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the Albany County Executive representing Albany County is authorized to execute agreements with The Sage Colleges, The Albany College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences, Siena College, the College of Saint Rose, Albany Law School, and the University of Albany pursuant the Governor's Enough is Enough Campaign which requires all colleges to adopt a set of comprehensive procedures and guidelines, including a uniform definition of affirmative consent, and expanded access to law enforcement to help prevent rape on college campuses in New York State, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
