

RESOLUTION NO. 442

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH REGARDING THE LOCAL IMPACT GRANT AND AMENDING THE 2015 HEALTH DEPARTMENT BUDGET

By Health Committee:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Health has been notified by the NYS Department of Health that funds are available for the Local IMPACT Grant, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has indicated that the grant funding will support the implementation of community and health system strategies to prevent and control obesity, diabetes, heart disease, stroke and reduce health disparities among adults, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Department of Health regarding a Local IMPACT Grant for the period beginning September 1, 2015 and ending September 29, 2016 in the amount of \$439,940, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner also requested a budget amendment in order to appropriate \$54,588 of funding into the 2015 Health Department Budget, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Department of Health, regarding a Local IMPACT Grant for the period beginning September 1, 2015 and ending September 29, 2016 in an amount not to exceed \$439,940, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2015 Health Department Budget is amended to incorporate said funding as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A4401 Public Health by \$54,588

Increase Appropriation Account A4010.2 by \$5,000 by increasing Line Item A4010 2 2050 Computer Equipment by \$5,000

Increase Appropriation Account A4010.4 by \$49,588 by increasing Line Item A4010 4 4046 Fees for Services by \$49,588

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Albany County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
