WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of General Services, after an RFP Process, has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with William Taylor Architects, PLLC regarding Architect and Engineering Services for the Hall of Records Expansion Project, and

WHEREAS, The Department of General Services, through the County Purchasing Agent, issued a request for bids regarding the Design and Construction Administration of the Proposed Building Expansion at the Albany County Hall of Records Facility on October 8, 2015, four bids were received, and

WHEREAS, The Department of General Services engineering staff and the County's Purchasing Agent reviewed said bids and recommended awarding the contract to William Taylor Architects, PLLC as the lowest bidder and offering the best value for Albany County, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with William Taylor Architects, PLLC, 6432 Baird Avenue, Syracuse, NY in an amount not to exceed \$124,945 regarding the Design and Construction Administration of the Proposed Building Expansion at the Albany County Hall of Records Facility, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
