WHEREAS, It is critical to make sure that the provider organizations are fiscally able to continue to provide the vital services that residents require without the possibility of interruption, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is requested to verify the fiscal stability of the organizations that the County depends on to provide critical assistance to the residents of Albany County and to confirm that there are no issues that might lead to an interruption of those required services, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
