

RESOLUTION NO. 76

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH PARSONS CHILD AND FAMILY CENTER REGARDING THE PROVISION OF CLINICAL PREVENTION SERVICES

By Social Services Committee:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Children, Youth and Families, after an RFP process, has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with Parsons Child and Family Center regarding the provision of clinical prevention services for the period commencing April 1, 2012 and ending December 31, 2012 in the amount of \$918,325, and

WHEREAS, Parsons Child and Family Center will provide comprehensive clinical prevention services and supportive services to families in Albany County with children, for pregnant teens or teen mothers with children who are at risk of out of home placement or are returning from foster care as the result of child abuse/neglect or PINS/JD issues, and

WHEREAS, The agreement also provides for comprehensive assessments, diagnostic testing, specialized therapies to children and their families, needed community service and resources for meeting basic food, clothing and shelter needs, child care, parent aide services, case planning, clinical support, and transportation services for families to receive services as well as for Family Court hearings, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Parsons Child and Family Center regarding the provision of clinical prevention services for the period commencing April 1, 2012 and ending December 31, 2012 in an amount not to exceed \$918,325, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
