

RESOLUTION NO. 80

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH TRINITY ALLIANCE OF THE CAPITAL REGION REGARDING THE PROVISION OF AFTER SCHOOL PREVENTION SERVICES

By Social Services Committee:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Children, Youth and Families has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with Trinity Alliance of the Capital Region regarding the provision of after school prevention services for the period commencing April 1, 2012 and ending December 31, 2012 in the amount of \$95,664, and

WHEREAS, Trinity Alliance of the Capital Region will provide after school, evening, school vacation and summer programming for elementary, middle and high school students ages six to seventeen who are at risk of out of home placement due to behavioral, emotional or psychiatric issues, and

WHEREAS, The agreement includes educational and recreational programs, case management, the provision of nutritious food and activities designed for the entire family, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Trinity Alliance of the Capital Region regarding the provision of after school prevention services for the period commencing April 1, 2012 and ending December 31, 2012 in the amount of \$95,664, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
