

RESOLUTION NO. 111

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 258 FOR 2011 REGARDING THE CR156 (FULLER ROAD) REHABILITATION PROJECT IN THE CITY OF ALBANY AND TOWNS OF COLONIE AND GUILDERLAND

By Public Works Committee, Messrs. Clay, Commisso and Joyce:

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 258 for 2011, this Honorable Body authorized an agreement with Rifenburg Construction, Inc. in an amount of \$12,738,151.75 regarding County Route CR156 (Fuller Road) Rehabilitation Project in the City of Albany and Towns of Colonie and Guilderland, and

WHEREAS, As a result of a review by the NYS Department of Transportation, the County was advised that changes were needed to the original design based upon studies that were being conducted on previously constructed roundabouts and the agreement with Rifenburg Construction, Inc. requires amendments to accommodate the necessary changes, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Public Works indicated that the proposed changes involve shifting the southeast quadrant of the Roundabout at Exit 2 at Fuller Road further into the banks of the Patroon Creek and will have impact on the existing access driveways of the adjacent commercial establishment, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner indicated that additional construction materials and services in the amount of \$581,000 are required to complete the project and the County will be fully reimbursed by the NYS Department of Transportation, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that Resolution No. 258 for 2011 is amended to reflect that the authorized amount of the agreement with Rifenburg Construction, Inc. is \$13,319,151.75 rather than \$12,738,151.75 regarding the County Route CR156 (Fuller Road) Rehabilitation Project in the City of Albany and Towns of Colonie and Guilderland, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said amended agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
