

RESOLUTION NO. 124

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH REGARDING THE CHILDHOOD LEAD PRIMARY PREVENTION PROGRAM AND AMENDING THE 2012 HEALTH DEPARTMENT BUDGET

By Health Committee and Ms. Maffia-Tobler:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Health has been notified by the NYS Department of Health that funds in the amount of \$378,929 are available to continue an ongoing grant pertaining to the Childhood Lead Primary Prevention Program, and

WHEREAS, The program seeks to reduce the prevalence of elevated blood lead levels in children through the implementation of a comprehensive program of primary and secondary prevention, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Department of Health regarding the Program for a term beginning April 1, 2012 and ending March 31, 2013, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Department of Health regarding the Childhood Lead Primary Prevention Program for the period April 1, 2012 and ending March 31, 2013 in an amount not to exceed \$378,929, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2012 Health Department Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A4409 Lead Poisoning Prev. Grant by \$136,932

Increase Appropriation Account A4010.4 by \$136,932 by increasing the following Line Items:

Increase Line Item A4010 4 4020 Office Supplies by \$12,094

Increase Line Item A4010 4 4039 Conference Training Tuition by \$73,500

Increase Line Item A4010 4 4042 Printing And Advertising by \$38,990

Increase Line Item A4010 4 4046 Fees For Services by \$12,348

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
