WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff has requested authorization to enter into an intermunicipal agreement with the Town of Guilderland regarding a Joint Emergency Response Team between the Albany County Sheriff's Department and Town of Guilderland Police Department, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has evaluated the proposed agreement for the period February 15, 2012 through December 31, 2017 and has determined that the terms and conditions of the agreement will provide for a more efficient utilization of law enforcement resources and services, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Town of Guilderland regarding a Joint Emergency Response Team for the period February 15, 2012 through December 31, 2017, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
