WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Public Works has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the Mohawk Hudson Land Conservancy, Inc., Town of New Scotland and the Village of Voorheesville regarding the improvement, use, management and maintenance of a section of the Rail Trail, and

WHEREAS, The license agreement would allow for the development, maintenance and management of recreational trail for use by the public along a section of the abandoned D&H railroad right-of-way owned by the County, now, therefore be it
