WHEREAS, In order to effectuate the purposes of this local law, it is necessary that certain intermunicipal agreements be entered into with the local municipalities within Albany County with respect to the participation of local police agencies, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into any necessary intermunicipal agreements to effectuate the purposes of the Precious Metals Exchanges and Secondhand Dealers Reporting Law, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreements as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
