AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO NYS EMPIRE STATE DEVELOPMENT REGARDING THE PRESERVATION AND REHABILITATION OF PARKS IN ALBANY COUNTY

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 414 for 2010, this Honorable Body requested the County Executive to seek NYS Local Government Efficiency Grant opportunities that might potentially benefit Albany County, and

WHEREAS, The County Executive has requested authorization to submit a grant application to the NYS Empire State Development regarding the preservation and rehabilitation of parks in Albany County, and

WHEREAS, The County Executive indicated that grant funding will be used for planning and development of the Ann Lee Preserve as well as the continued development of the Albany County rail trail, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to submit a grant application to the NYS Empire State Development regarding the preservation and rehabilitation of parks in Albany County including the development of the Ann Lee Preserve and the continued development of the Albany County rail trail, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said grant application as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
