## AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 267 FOR 2008 TO UPDATE THE SPECIAL NURSING HOME FACILITIES COMMITTEE TO INCLUDE ELDER CARE ISSUES WITHIN THE COMMITTEE'S JURISDICTION

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 267 for 2008, this Honorable Body established the Special Nursing Home Facilities Committee to evaluate and make recommendations concerning all matters which the committee may deem appropriate relating to the construction of a new nursing home, and

WHEREAS, The provision of other necessary services beyond providing nursing home care, including in-home care, assisted living and other special services to the elderly is an important part of the mission of Albany County, and

WHEREAS, These services should be considered as part of the entire scope of services provided to the elderly population by Albany County, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that Resolution No. 267 for 2008 is amended to reflect that the Special Nursing Home Facilities Committee be renamed to the Special Committee on Elder Care and said committee's jurisdiction includes evaluating and making recommendations concerning the provision of services to the elderly population of Albany County including, but not limited to, all matters which the committee may deem appropriate relating to construction of a new Albany County Nursing Home, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That said Special Committee on Elder Care shall consist of nine members and the following named persons are hereby appointed to said Special Committee:
