AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH SUNY AT ALBANY REGARDING A STUDENT INTERN FIELD PLACEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Crime Victim and Sexual Violence Center Director has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the State University at Albany School of Social Welfare regarding a Student Intern Field Placement Program, and

WHEREAS, The State University at Albany will locate and refer student interns for field work placement at the Crime Victim and Sexual Violence Center and the District Attorney's Office at no cost to Albany County, and

WHEREAS, The District Attorney's Office utilizes student interns to meet the NYS requirements for volunteers in order to receive grant funding, and

WHEREAS, The Director indicated that the agreement is intended to clarify responsibilities, defines working relationships between the two organizations and allows for the University to provide a corresponding certificate of insurance, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the University at Albany School of Social Welfare regarding a Student Intern Field Placement Program, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
