WHEREAS, The Director of the Probation Department has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the City of Albany regarding the Juvenile Justice Mobile Response Team Grant Program in an amount not to exceed \$60,000 commencing July 1, 2012 and ending May 31, 2013, and

WHEREAS, The purpose of the grant is for the Probation Department to provide staff to support the implementation of a Juvenile Justice Mobile Response Team that will assess and evaluate all individuals charged with Juvenile Delinquency at the point of arrest, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the City of Albany regarding the Juvenile Justice Mobile Response Team Grant Program in an amount not to exceed \$60,000 commencing July 1, 2012 and ending May 31, 2013, and, be it further
