WHEREAS, The Director of the Probation Department has requested authorization to enter into a data use agreement with SUNY Research Foundation/University at Albany regarding the provision of front-end Juvenile Justice data for a Juvenile Justice Mobile Response Team, and

WHEREAS, The Director has indicated that the purpose of the grant is to provide assessment, referral and linkage to determine the program's effectiveness; and to provide evaluators with access to data necessary to assess the program goals, decrease unnecessary use of detention and reduce the penetration of youth into the criminal justice system in all other ways, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into a data use agreement with SUNY Research Foundation/University at Albany regarding the provision of front-end Juvenile Justice data for a Juvenile Justice Mobile Response Team through May 31, 2013, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
