AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT REGARDING THE CONTINUANCE OF THE STORMWATER COALITION

Introduced: 9/10/12 By Public Works Committee:

WHEREAS, The Cities of Albany, Cohoes and Watervliet, the Towns of Bethlehem, Colonie, Guilderland and New Scotland, and the Villages of Colonie, Green Island, Menands and Voorheesville have indicated a desire to continue the Stormwater Coalition, and

WHEREAS, The eleven municipalities and the County are subject to State regulations regarding municipal separate storm water systems and are cooperatively working towards permit compliance by entering into an intermunicipal agreement continuing a member-funded Stormwater Coalition, and

WHEREAS, The proposed agreement would require member funding for the Stormwater Coalition in the annual amount of \$120,000 with Albany County committing \$7,000 per year and \$8,000 for in-kind services annually through December 31, 2015, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an inter-municipal agreement with the Cities of Albany, Cohoes and Watervliet, the Towns of Bethlehem, Colonie, Guilderland and New Scotland, and the Villages of Colonie, Green Island, Menands and Voorheesville regarding the continuation of the Stormwater Coalition as indicated above through December 31, 2015, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the continuation of the Stormwater Coalition agreement has complied with the State Environmental Quality Review Act and it has been determined that the proposed Unlisted Action will not have a significant impact on the environment, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
