

RESOLUTION NO. 373

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS OFFICE FOR THE AGING REGARDING THE PROVISION OF SUPPORTIVE SERVICES FOR SENIORS IN ALBANY COUNTY AND AMENDING THE 2012 DEPARTMENT FOR AGING BUDGET

By Social Services Committee and Mr. Clenahan:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Aging has been notified by the NYS Office for the Aging that funds are available for various supportive service programs to provide transportation, adult day care services, case management, preventive health services, shopping assistance and supportive services for low income persons in Albany County, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging in the amount of \$354,718 commencing January 1, 2012 and ending December 31, 2012 regarding Supportive Services Programs for seniors in Albany County, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has also requested a budget amendment in order to appropriate \$11,005 of the aforementioned funding into the 2012 budget, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Office for the Aging in the amount of \$354,718 commencing January 1, 2012 and ending December 31, 2012 regarding Supportive Services Programs for seniors in Albany County, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2012 Department for Aging Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A4773 Supportive Services Grant by \$11,005

Increase Appropriation Account A6772.4 by \$11,005 by increasing Line Item A6772 4 4046 Fees for Services by \$11,005

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
