

RESOLUTION NO. 429

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH SUNY AT ALBANY SCHOOL OF SOCIAL WELFARE REGARDING A STUDENT INTERN PLACEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Director of the Department of Mental Health has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the State University at Albany School of Social Welfare regarding a Student Intern Placement Program, and

WHEREAS, The State University at Albany will locate and refer student interns for clinical field work placement at the Department of Mental Health at no cost to Albany County, and

WHEREAS, The agreement allows students to gain clinical field work experience and in return the students provide supervised services to our patients, and

WHEREAS, The Director indicated that the agreement clarifies responsibilities, defines working relationships between the two organizations and allows for the University to provide a corresponding certificate of insurance, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the University at Albany School of Social Welfare regarding a Student Intern Placement Program for clinical field work at the Department of Mental Health, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
