

RESOLUTION NO. 454

**AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS CANAL CORPORATION
REGARDING THE REIMBURSEMENT FOR MARINE PATROL SERVICES
ALONG THE CANALS AND CANAL WAY TRAIL**

By Public Safety Committee:

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the NYS Canal Corporation regarding the reimbursement for Marine Patrol Services along the canals and canal-way trail in the amount of \$30,000 with a 25% County match up to a maximum amount of \$7,500 commencing April 1, 2012 and ending March 31, 2013, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff indicated that funding will be used to enforce efforts in the waterways leading into the canal system at the Hudson River entry point, providing a unique opportunity to enforce maritime regulations prior to entry into the canal thus making the canal system safer for its users, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Canal Corporation regarding the reimbursement for Marine Patrol Services along the canals and canal-way trail in the amount of \$30,000 with a 25% County match up to a maximum amount of \$7,500 commencing April 1, 2012 and ending March 31, 2013, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
