

RESOLUTION NO. 478

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CENTER FOR FAMILY AND YOUTH REGARDING THE PROVISION OF CLINICAL PREVENTION SERVICES

By Social Services Committee:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Children, Youth and Families, after an RFP process, has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with Center for Family and Youth regarding the provision of clinical prevention services for the period commencing January 1, 2013 and ending December 31, 2013 in the amount of \$652,547, and

WHEREAS, The Center for Family and Youth will provide comprehensive clinical prevention services and supportive services to families in Albany County with children ages birth through eighteen who are at risk of out of home placement or are returning from foster care as the result of child abuse/neglect or PINS/JD issues, and

WHEREAS, the agreement provides comprehensive assessment, diagnostic testing, case and specialized therapies provided by a person who has received a Master of Social Work degree, Master of Mental Health Counseling degree or is a licensed Psychologist, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Center for Family and Youth regarding the provision of clinical prevention services for the period commencing January 1, 2013 and ending December 31, 2013 in the amount of \$652,547, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
