

RESOLUTION NO. 485

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH CORNELL COOPERATIVE EXTENSION REGARDING SUPERVISION AND TREATMENT SERVICES FOR JUVENILES AND THEIR FAMILIES

By Social Services Committee and Mr. Clenahan:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department of Social Services has requested an agreement with Cornell Cooperative Extension regarding the provision of supervision and treatment services for juveniles and their families in Albany County, and

WHEREAS, Cornell Cooperative Extension will be delivering an Urban 4-H Program to engage at-risk youth in educational programming designed to help them realize their full potential and identify specific assets and strengths they possess to give them a sense of purpose and assist them in becoming productive citizens; and a Strengthening Families series to strengthen parenting skills, build family strengths, and prevent teen substance abuse and other behavioral problems, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Cornell Cooperative Extension regarding the provision of the aforementioned services to in the amount of \$100,000 to commence on January 1, 2013 and terminate December 31, 2013, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the fees to be paid shall not exceed \$100,000, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
