

RESOLUTION NO. 94

AUTHORIZING AGREEMENTS WITH VARIOUS MUNICIPALITIES REGARDING PARTICIPATION IN THE ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT SERVICES PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff's Department and the Towns of Bethlehem, Berne, Rensselaerville, Westerlo, Coeymans and New Scotland wish to enter into agreements for the towns' participation in the County's Emergency Medical Services Program in order to provide Advanced Life Support services in the southern and western areas of Albany County, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has evaluated the proposed services to be rendered for a period beginning January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011 and has determined that the amounts due from each town shall be as follows:

Town of Bethlehem	\$761,079.34
Town of Berne	\$ 66,703.20
Town of Rensselaerville	\$ 43,847.34
Town of Westerlo	\$ 80,720.54
Town of Coeymans	\$185,079.51
Town of New Scotland	\$203,470.07

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into agreements with the above-listed towns for the period beginning January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011 in the amounts listed above, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreements as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
