

RESOLUTION NO. 168

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH ST. ANNE INSTITUTE REGARDING THE PROVISION OF SPECIALIZED CLINICAL PREVENTION SERVICES FOR JUVENILE SEX OFFENDERS

By Social Services Committee and Mr. Scavo:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Children, Youth and Families has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with St. Anne Institute regarding the provision of specialized clinical prevention services for juvenile sex offenders for the period commencing April 1, 2011 and ending March 31, 2012 in the amount of \$216,755, and

WHEREAS, The St. Anne Institute Prevention Program for juvenile sex offenders provides services for children from age ten through eighteen who have engaged in sexually inappropriate, aggressive or abusive behavior and their families, and

WHEREAS, St. Anne Institute services are designed to assist families in maintaining their children at home, preventing children from entering foster care and by providing services for youth discharged from foster care, and

WHEREAS, The agreement provides linkage to needed community services and resources, comprehensive assessments, case planning, clinical services, and transportation services for families to receive services, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with St. Anne Institute regarding the provision of specialized clinical prevention services for juvenile sex offenders for the period commencing April 1, 2011 and ending March 31, 2012 in the amount of \$216,755, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
